Items b, c and d will be given directly by the foundation to the scholar concerned via deposit to his/her Meritbank Savings Account.

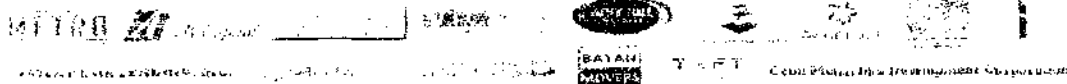
TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

 - d. Must not accept any other scholarship grant while enrolled in this scholarship;
 - e. Must not accept any kind of employment while on scholarship, the intent is to devote full time on his/her studies; and
 - f. Must not commit fraud, dishonesty, crime, scandalous or immoral behavior nor violate the rules and regulations of the school.
- Failure to attend classes due to poor health, pregnancy, disciplinary action and any conduct which to our evaluation will contravene the objectives and standards of the FOUNDATION and the SETKAD shall result termination of the scholarship Grant.
