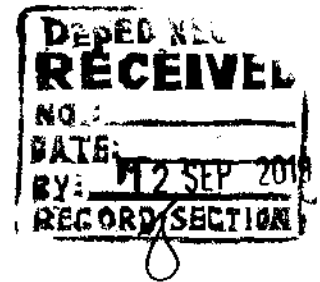


Transportation allowance and snacks of the participants will be provided by the organizer during the qualifying and championship events.

## Proposed Mechanics for the

### DCCCO AFLACHAMP MODERN DANCE COMPETITION 2019

Semi-Finals: October 19, 2019 (Saturday), 9:00 A.M.

4<sup>th</sup> Floor, DCCCO Multipurpose Cooperative, Santa Rosa St. Dumaguete City

Finals: November 30, 2019 (Saturday), 1:00 PM

Venue: To be decided

#### Mechanics:

1. Twenty-four (24) Schools are invited to participate in the Competition. Each school will have one (1) team to represent them.
2. Members of the competing team must be enrolled in the Aflatoun Program.
3. Each group will have a minimum of eight (8) and maximum of twelve (12) members and shall be composed of selected grade 4, 5 and 6 elementary students and for high school grade 7, 8, 9, and 10 only.
4. The members of the groups may be composed of all males or females, or any combination of both.
5. Music should be wholesome and lively and must not contain any subliminal, sexually suggestive, and vulgar lyrics/language.
6. The music must be at least three (3) minutes but not more than five (5) minutes. Any excess in time will have 1 point deduction/minute to the total score.
7. Use of props will be allowed as long as it will not cause any delay in the program and any harm to the performance of other groups. Props such as oil, confetti, pyrotechnic gadgets, smoke generators or combustible material, broken glass, live animals, sharp objects and the like are prohibited.
8. Choreography should not be vulgar and must not contain any subliminal or sexually suggestive act.
9. Participation in the event is entirely at the dancers' own risk. Performance of dangerous choreography will be not be reflected favorably in the scoring.
10. Appropriate attire should be observed through-out the competition. Removing pieces of clothing during the performance is allowed provided that it is not offensive or out of character.
11. The criteria for judging are the following:
 

1. Choreography (Creativity, Artistry, Style & Originality)	-	50%
2. Execution (Timing & Coordination, Projection & Expression)	-	30%
3. Costume	-	10%
4. Audience Impact	-	<u>10%</u>
