- 3. MUST COME FROM POOR FAMILIES WITH MONTHLY INCOME OF PHP 5, 000.00 OR BELOW.
- 4. NO BROTHERS AND SISTERS STUDYING IN ANY OF OUR SCHOOLS AND/OR A GRADUATE OF OUR SCHOOLS-SISTERS OF MARY SCHOOL.
- 5. FOR ELEMENTARY GRADUATES, HEISHE MUST PRESENT HIS/HER ORIGINAL GRADE VI CARD DURING THE QUALIFYING TEST.
- 6. FOR THOSE WHO ARE PRESENTLY IN GRADE VI, THEY MUST SECURE CERTIFICATION FROM THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL INDICATING THAT THEY ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED AND HAVE A GENERAL AVERAGE OF 83 AND ABOVE ON THEIR LATEST GRADING PERIOD.
- THEY MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY ONE OF THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIAN ON THE DAY OF THE EXAMINATION.
- 8. THEY MUST PRESENT THEIR PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) LIVE BIRTH CERTIFICATE AUTHENTI-CATION WITH 1X1 ID PICTURE (2 COPIES) AND BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE (PHOTOCOPY). DURING THE EXAMINA-TION WHICH WILL BEGIN @8AM. THE APPLICANTS MUST BRING A PEN AND WHAT IS ASKED IN CONDITIONS 5-8, WHICHEVER CATEGORY HE/SHE BELONGS.
