

## Rationale

The 11 Days of Sharing Program is one of the highlight event during the Hibalag Booth Festival and most importantly the 118<sup>th</sup> founding celebration of Silliman University. It is an event organized in cooperation with the Silliman University Extension Program (SUEP), the Silliman University Student Government (SUSG), Student Organizations and Activities Division (SOAD), Office of Student Services (OSS), the Committee on Student Organizations (COMSO), and the different units of Silliman University.

**11 Days of Sharing** is organized to connect and to gather partners from different communities and sectors of Silliman University. These partners then engage and participate in lectures, seminars, fun activities and games. The SUEP acts as a bridge between SUSG Executive Committees and the various agencies and partners within Dumaguete. For each of the 11 days, a committee from SUSG will be assigned a partner agency/community in which they are to prepare and to organize activities and/or games and the necessary provisions (e.g. snacks and tokens) in upholding the event. Student organizations and the different units of Silliman University shall sponsor the partner agency/community, providing the resources needed by each SUSG committee in carrying out the activities in their program. COMSO will serve as a facilitator/coordinator during the whole event.

The aim of this event is (1) to encourage/foster collaboration (among sectors and all organizations as a whole) and not competition, (2) to unite Sillimanians from all walks of life providing an avenue for fun and meaningful activities, the celebration of diversity, and for people to connect, re-connect and create memories through sharing, (3) to showcase Silliman University and its dynamic student life environment to non-Sillimanians, with emphasis on the school's heritage and legacies, thereby cultivating goodwill, and (4) to share not only an event, not only the resources, but also, to share an experience to the community—the HIBALAG EXPERIENCE.

This is where students, faculty members and staff come together for the value of volunteerism and camaraderie to help agencies/communities in need. This engagement, allows the Silliman university to once again re-connect with the community outside its gates and to continue sharing education and experiences and to create relationship that transcend social barriers. With the 11 Days of Sharing, we can then bring into light Silliman's mission of faith and unity amongst people. This is *Via, Veritas, Vita, now and always.*
