

2019 YMCA OUTSTANDING STUOENT AWARDS (YMCA-OSA)

I. Brief Description

The YMCA Outstanding Student Awards (YMCA-OSA) is a community level recognition of the achievements of students. Its objectives are as follow:

- a. To motivate individuals and further develop their talents and potentials;
- b. To promote and stimulate mass participation and involvement in human resources development—the youth in the community;
- c. To give students an incentive to work harder and get involved in school and community activities aimed at leadership development;
- d. To help provide education with opportunities in further development to students capabilities and potentials; and
- e. To promote goodwill with students, teachers and parents in the community.

II. Number of Awardees and Criteria for Selection

A. Elementary Level

- 1. Each elementary school is entitled to recommend two (2) awardees to be selected from among the graduating pupils for the current school year.
- 2. The selection shall be by a committee to be organized by the School principal based on the following criteria:

a. Academic Standing	-	40%
b. Achievements and Honors Received	-	20%
c. Personal Talents and Skills	-	15%
d. Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities	-	10%
e. Inter-Personal Relations	-	10%
* Student – Teacher		
* Student – Student		
* with other group, organization, community, etc.		
f. Personal Interview	-	5%

B. Senior High School Level

- 1. Each high school having graduating students of 200 or less is entitled to recommend two (2) awardees and one more awardees for every additional 200 graduating students for the current school year.
- 2. The selection shall be done by a committee to be organized by the School Principal/Head based on the following criteria:

a. Academic Standing	-	30%
b. Co—curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities	-	20%
c. Personal Talents and Skills	-	20%
d. Achievements and Honors Received	-	15%
e. Inter-Personal Relations	-	10%
*Student – Teacher

*with other Group, organization, community, etc.		
f. Personal Interview	-	5%

C. Vocational Schools

- 1. Each vocational school is entitled to recommend two (2) awardees to be selected from among the graduating students for the current year.
- 2. The selection shall be done by a committee to be organized by the School Principal/Head based on the following criteria:

a. Academic Standing	-	30%
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b. Co-curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities	-	20%
c. Personal Talents and Skills	-	20%
d. Achievements and Honors Received	-	15%
e. Inter-Personal Relations	-	10%
*Student – Teacher

*With other group, organization, community, etc.		
f. Personal Interview	-	5%

D. College Level

1. The following colleges and universities are entitled to recommend awardees as follows:

c. Personal Talents and Skills	-	20%
d. Achievements and Honors Received	-	15%
e. Inter-Personal Relations	-	10%

f. Personal Interview	-	5%

- III. All awardees shall be required to fill up a Personal Information Sheet duly certified by the School Principals/Head/Director/Dean and which shall be submitted to the YMCA not later than **March 16, 2019**.
- IV. The recommendation of the School Screening Committee when submitted to the YMCA shall be final.
- V. Names of the awardees per school will be immediately acknowledged and publicized over the different Radio and TV Stations.
- VI. The **Awardees Recognition Program** will be held on **March 21, 2019 at 1:30 PM** for the **Senior High Schools, Vocational Schools & College Level** and **March 22, 2019 at 1:30PM** for the **Elementary Level** at the YMCA Conference Hall, YMCA Guest House & Conference Center, Talay Dumaguete City. The School Heads and parents are invited to attend the program. Awardees are encouraged to wear their school uniforms during the Recognition Program.
