- In line with the **2019 DIWANG: Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas**, this office reiterates the conduct of **Divisional Level Competition and Festival on Diwang: Sagisag Kultura ng Filipinas on August 2, 2019 in Dumaguete City.**

Contest	Results of the Deliberation
Awiting Bayan Kundiman Competition Contest Administrator: Mrs. J. Cabajon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The contestant must be <u>ONE public high school student per municipality.</u> The Coach/Trainer of this category must be a teacher in his/her Municipality. The presentation of the Kundiman must run from <u>2 to 3 minutes.</u> <u>Photocopied musical scores in 4 copies</u> must be submitted to <u>Mrs. Jenith Corpis Cabajon personally on July 29, 2019 for Originality Check.</u> If musical scores are not original then, <u>entry means disqualification from such category.</u>
Laro ng Lahi Contest Administrators: Mr. Allan Tabio & Mrs. Esterlina Paragoso	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <u>SIYATONG</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The player must only be <u>ONE Male Grade 8-10 High School student to play with the 5 games.</u> Credentials needed are Certificate of Enrolment, Medical Certificate and Parent's Consent excluding coach. Official materials for Siatong will be provided by the Contest Administrator like Sticks (Pamakang of 24 inches, Pamitiw of 8 inches and Felt Tip (Pentel) Pen -Sized diameter) Single Elimination with 3 innings is the preferred type of competition. Required Skills are Ligwat, Pakang and Palagtiw. During the pamakang, the pamitiw will be released first before striking. When the player exhibited Palagtiw with 2 hits, the distance will be measured by the use of pamakang while if 3 hits be performed then, pamitiw will be used for measuring its distance. <u>TRUMPO</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The trumpo's head has a circumference of 7 inches, its height is 3 and a half inches including the nail. Spinning base is a concrete floor with a diameter of 50 cms. If the spinning top will go beyond the base, it is not counted. There will be three (3) try outs and the highest time will be taken as the final score.

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	<p>3. <u>LUKSONG LUBID (Individual)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The player will jump with two feet landing the ground together in every jump at non-stop for 3 minutes. The highest number of jumps wins. If only one foot will touch the ground, the number of jumps before the violation will be the final score. Wearing of pair of shoes is a must. <p>4. <u>SIPA</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The playing time is 3 minutes with 3 try outs. Only inward kicking is allowed. The striking foot should touch the ground before taking another kick. The player has the option to use his foot alternately. The number of kicks before the violation will be the final score. Wearing of pair of shoes is a must. <p>5. <u>KADANG-KADANG</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The bamboo pole has a height of 10 feet. The step must be situated two feet (24 inches) from the bottom. Materials to be used are the pure bamboo and nails only. This game has a 50- meter race. The best time will determine the winner. <p>Note: Please don't ignore.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To determine the overall winner is through the highest number of golds. In case of tie, the number of silver and bronze will be the tie breaker. If it will still be on a tie, a toss of coin will be done. All Materials for Laro ng Lahi will be officially provided for by the Contest Administrator except KADANG-KADANG which must be taken care of by the municipality, following the specifications cited above.

Juanillo</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The team is composed of <u>3 public high school students (Grades 7-12) and 1 coach/ trainer.</u> The team may have mixed grade levels. The piece must be in Filipino medium and originally composed by the team observing the theme cited in Regional Memo 0359 s. 2019 which is, <i>"Makatarungan ba ang pasya ng Korte Suprema tungkol sa wika at panitikang Filipino sa kolehiyo?"</i>
<p>Kwiz</p> <p>Contest Administrator: Dr. C. Alcala</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each municipality only has <u>ONE representative.</u> (Grade 7-10 student) The review materials which definitely is the basis for the quiz are the soft copies of 2000 cultural symbols and icons shared through your district coordinators. Due to time constraints, the form of quiz to take place on August 2 is yet in paper-pencil test however, it is understood that whoever will the Division Winner will intensively practice the Digital Type of Quiz along with the Coach in his or her municipality with the coordination of the Division. Each representative must bring his or her pencil with an eraser.
<p>Visual Arts On the Spot</p> <p>Contest Administrator: Mr. A. Jungco</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only <u>ONE DepEd JHS/SHS student</u> represents his or her municipality. A cartolina- size Canvass and acrylic paints of 5 colors (black, white, red, blue and yellow) will be used and must be provided by the municipality the student represents. The Theme will be "SAGISAG KULTURA: SA MATA NG KABATAANG FILIPINO." The painting session starts from 9:00 am- 5:00 pm The created art must have a caption in a form of a title and a brief description written on a bond paper to be hung at the bottom or mounted at the top of the painting. The painting must have an original concept of the artist representing each municipality
