### **3<sup>rd</sup> QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED)**

**TO :** Assistant Schools Division Superintendents  
SGOD and CID Chief, Education Program Supervisors/Division Coordinators  
Section Heads / Education Programs Specialists  
Public Schools District Supervisors/Districts-In-Charge  
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
District DRRM Coordinators/Alternates/School DRRM Coordinators

1. Relative to DepEd Memorandum dated August 5, 2019, the conduct of **CY 2019 Third Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)** scheduled on August 8, 2019 shall be moved on **August 16, 2019 at 8:00 AM** and the following objectives shall be observed:
  - a) To evaluate the readiness and awareness of learners and DepEd personnel for earthquake; and,
  - b) To evaluate the coordination and communication mechanism during evacuation procedures and response.
2. Public and private schools are directed to actively join and participate to create a culture of awareness and evaluate school contingency/evacuation plans on what to do in times of emergencies.
3. To test the efficiency and usefulness of the preparedness response and recovery plans, systems and policies developed in respective schools, **District DRRM Coordinators and Alternates will serve as evaluators of the schools listed in the attachment.**
4. All schools shall thoroughly follow the guidelines below; non-compliance is tantamount to non-acceptance of said reports.
  - School DRRM Coordinators shall submit the reports only to respective District Offices not later than three (3) work days after the activity.
  - District DRRM Coordinators/Alternates shall consolidate NSED reports from the schools and shall submit only to Division Office not later than ten (10) work days after the activity through the online form at <http://bit.ly/NSEDnegor>
5. Travelling and other incidental expenses of the evaluators shall be chargeable against school MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and guidelines.
6. This serves as Travel Order.
7. For immediate dissemination and compliance.

**SUBJECT :** **3rd QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL**

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In relation to the approved memorandum no. OUA-MEMO-12-0119-0083 "CY 2019 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills" and NDRRMC Memorandum No. 63s, 2019 "Conduct of the CY 2019 Third Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)", the event and the quarterly periodical exam are scheduled on the same date, **08 August 2019**. As such, the Regional Offices and Division Offices may move the 3rd quarter NSED for the schools to a later date in coordination with their respective Office of the Civil Defense (OCD) or the Local Government Unit (LGU).

With this, we are requesting the Regional and Division DRRM Coordinators to inform the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) for the new schedule and observe the following objectives:

1. To evaluate the readiness and awareness of learners and DepEd personnel on earthquakes; and,
2. To evaluate the coordination and communication mechanisms during evacuation procedures and response.

Proper documentation and post-activity evaluation of said drill are required. All field offices are advised to make necessary preparations to ensure that the required reports are submitted on time (**Annex A**).

**Annex A. Guidelines for the Memorandum on the Conduct of the 2019 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills (NSED)**

All schools, school division offices, and regional offices should thoroughly follow the guidelines below; non-compliance is tantamount to non-acceptance of said reports.

1. School DRRM Coordinators will submit the reports, pictures and videos to respective Division DRRM Coordinators not later than two (2) days after the quarterly NSED.
2. Division DRRM Coordinators will consolidate NSED reports; pictures and videos from School DRRM Coordinators and will submit only to respective Regional DRRM Coordinators copy furnish their respective Schools Division Superintendent not later than 10 days after the quarterly NSED copy furnish DRRMS through [drmo+NSED2019@deped.gov.ph](mailto:drmo+NSED2019@deped.gov.ph).
3. Regional DRRM Coordinators will consolidate NSED reports, pictures and videos from Division DRRM Coordinators and will submit to the DRRMS copy furnish their respective Regional Directors. Consolidated reports regarding the documentation and analysis of the Quarterly NSED must be submitted to [drmo+NSED2019@deped.gov.ph](mailto:drmo+NSED2019@deped.gov.ph) not later than 20 days after the quarterly NSED.
4. Cut-off time for all deadlines will be at 5:00 PM.
5. Regional DRRM Coordinators should use the naming convention below for emails:
