The College of Education at Silliman University is to launching its year-long Centennial celebration from August 2019 to August 2020 with the theme "su.edu@100: Bearing the Fruits of the Spirit through a Century of Christ-centered Transformative Education." This based on historical records as summarized by historian SU VPAA Dr. Earl Jude Paul L. Cleope, which states that:

[t]he College of Education started as a department of Silliman Institute in 1919 offering the High School Teacher's Certificate (HST) and the Bachelor of Science in Education (BSE) curriculum, which was offered in 1920. In 1924, Silliman Institute granted its first Bachelor of Science in Education degrees to six of its graduates.... In 1935, a Board of Trustees Action reorganized the Department of Education into a college which was to have both undergraduate and graduate divisions, and designated the elementary and high school as laboratory schools... Dr. Clyde Heflin was appointed as the first dean.... (College of Education Graduate Program Handbook, 2012, p. 6).

In line with this, the College of Education Centennial Celebration Committee (COE-CCC) has planned a series of events aimed at 1) honoring the people that have germinated the College of Education seed and nurtured its growth through its one hundred years of service to the Philippines and beyond, 2) commemorating the significant events during its 100 years of existence, and 3) giving glory to God for the gift of education through the College of Education at Silliman.

Among the events to launch the year-long celebration is the Balik Talent Lecture Series by Department of Education Secretary Leonor Briones on August 24, 2019 at 3:00-6:00 P.M. at the Audio-Visual Theater 1 near the Silliman University Main Library. We are cordially inviting you and the DepEd personnel in your Division to attend the lecture on Public Policies in Education by the Secretary herself. This is one rare occasion for updating on current trends in public service.
