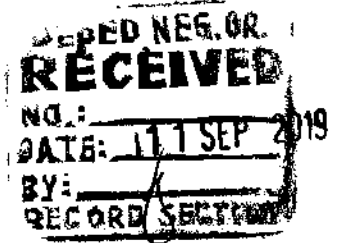

RULES AND GUIDELINES

A. Eligibility and Membership

The competition is open to all children 6 – 14 years old who are Filipino citizens with one (1) conductor and not more than two (2) accompanists.

The choir shall be accompanied by either guitar/s and/or piano.

Conductor and choir members can perform with only one (1) choir.

B. Application and Registration

LGU/Schools and other Institutions shall be encouraged to enter their choir.

Participating choir must submit to the Committee at the Provincial Tourism Office not later than **04:00 PM, Friday, September 20, 2019**, the following:

- ❖ Entry Form duly accomplished.
- ❖ One (1) copy of the certified list of names and birthdates of choir members, and
- ❖ Three (3) copies of the actual musical scores.

C. Repertoire

The Choir shall choose its own repertoire provided that these shall be Original Pilipino Music (OPM), one in English and another in any Philippine dialect.

Pieces must be composed or arranged for SSA (Soprano 1, Soprano 11, and Alto).

D. Performance

Participating choirs must come to the competition in proper attire.

All songs shall be memorized. No choreography or body movement is allowed unless specified in the score. Changing choral formation to suit the sound or context of a work is allowed provided it is done between renditions.

Singing time for each choir is limited to five (5) minutes, excluding entrance and exit.

No sets, backdrop and hand props will be allowed.

The decision of the Panel of Judges will be considered final and un-appealable.

1. Each municipality/city of Negros Oriental or any institution therein shall be encouraged to submit one (1) official entry duly recognized by the Local Chief Executive/DepEd Principal/Head of Institution.
2. Each contingent shall be composed of **16 performers ages 15 to 20 years old**.
3. Dance entry must be taken from any published books of Philippine Folkdances by Francisca Reyes /Tolentino/ Aquino, Philippine Folk Dance Society Sayaw Series, Classic Philippine Folkdances Collections, Handumanan: Collection of Visayan Folk Dances, among others.
4. Each contingent shall provide for its own canned music and must be stored in CD/USB/Mp3 file together with 5 sets of photocopied dance literature placed and fastened inside a short-sized white paper folder for reference and perusal of the contest committee and judges.
5. Total performing time must depend on the running time of the chosen piece with an additional of 1 minute entrance and exit.
6. Each contingent shall wear appropriate costumes including appropriate hand held props, body implements and appropriate footwear based on the submitted dance literature.
7. Props may be used but must be minimal and readily transportable on and off stage.
8. Qualified entries must submit duly accomplished Entry Forms together with their dance literature 2 weeks prior to the competition date for review by the contest committee which will qualify them to join the competition. **Only the first 12 entries** are entitled to join in the competition.
9. The contingent shall be judged according to the following criteria:

• Execution / Performance (Rhythm and Grace)	20%
• Mastery, Discipline, Teamwork)	20%
• Appropriateness of Costumes, Props (if any)	20%
• Interpretation/ Choreography / Theme	30%
• Over-all Impact (Visual, Audience Appeal)	10%

2. There is no age limit as long as the student is officially enrolled.
3. Each entry shall be composed of 8 to 10 members excluding one (1) conductor. They will be required to bring their own musical instruments during the competition (acoustic guitar, bass, beat box). Drum set and keyboards are not allowed during the competition.
4. Each group will perform their own choice of music with a time limit of 10 minutes including the set up of instruments. They have to prepare two (2) OPM compositions (Filipino, English, or Visayan).
5. The use of props, smoke or combustible materials are not allowed.
6. Medley arrangement of songs is not allowed.
7. Band members must not wear clothing that may depict any picture or language that might be deemed offensive.
8. Only the **first 15** participating acoustic bands to submit duly accomplished entry forms should be qualified to join the competition.
