### 4<sup>th</sup> QUARTER NATIONWIDE SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED)

District DRRM Coordinators/Alternates/School DRRM Coordinators

1. Relative to OUA Memorandum dated October 30, 2019, all DepEd offices and schools shall participate in the conduct of the **CY 2019 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)** scheduled on **November 14, 2019 at 2:00 PM** with the following objectives:
  - a) To evaluate the readiness and awareness of learners and DepEd personnel for earthquake; and,
  - b) To evaluate the coordination and communication mechanism during evacuation procedures and response.
2. Public and private schools are directed to actively join and participate to create a culture of awareness and evaluate school contingency/evacuation plans on what to do in times of emergencies.
3. To test the efficiency and usefulness of the preparedness response and recovery plans, systems and policies developed in respective schools, **District DRRM Coordinators and Alternates will serve as evaluators of the schools listed in the attachment.**
4. All schools shall thoroughly follow the guidelines below; non-compliance is tantamount to non-acceptance of said reports.
  - School DRRM Coordinators shall submit the reports only to respective District Offices not later than three (3) work days after the activity.
  - District DRRM Coordinators/Alternates shall consolidate NSED reports from the schools and shall submit only to Division Office not later than ten (10) work days after the activity through the online form at <http://bit.ly/NSEDnegor>
5. Travelling and other incidental expenses of the evaluators shall be chargeable against school MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and guidelines.
6. This serves as Travel Order.

- Insufficient drill equipment

### General Recommendations

Based on the evaluation submitted from our district offices, here are the following recommendations:

- Clearing activity on the identified holding area a day before the conduct of NSED to assure safety during the drill;
- Conduct earthquake awareness campaign to the community;
- Drill and related DRRM equipment should be integrated in SiP and AIP;
- Drill must be done once every month;
