


7. **Checking of laptops and memory cards** will take place on **November 27, 2019 at 8:00 am to 5:00 pm at Mandaue City Comprehensive National High School for secondary level and at Mandaue City Central Elem. School for the elementary level.**

2019 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, also known as the *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, this Office announces the conduct of the **2019 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** with the theme, "*Empowering Communities through Campus Journalism.*" This will be held on November 27-30, 2019 in Mandaue City to be hosted by Mandaue City Division.
2. The conference aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding on the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - c. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in Journalism as a career or those who intend to use skill sets learned through campus journalism to give them a better edge in their chosen careers;
 - d. promote responsible journalism, fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
3. Participants to the 2019 RSPC are the following:
 - a. the top five (5) Division winners of the different individual writing contests in English and Filipino of both elementary and secondary levels;
 - b. Division first place winners in Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting, Collaborative Publishing, TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting (for secondary level only), and Online Publishing (for secondary level only);
 - c. School Paper Advisers;
 - d. Division Journalism Coordinators
 - e. Board of Judges
 - f. Division and Region Technical Working Group
4. The Conference activities shall include the following:
 - a. Individual Contests (News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Sports Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Photojournalism, Science and Technology Writing, and Column Writing as exhibition contest)
 - b. Group Contests (Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting, Collaborative Desktop Publishing, TV Script Writing and Broadcasting, and Online Publishing)
 - c. School Paper Advisers' (SPA) Category (News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Sports Writing in English, Filipino and Binisayang Sinugboanon). Photojournalism is also part of the SPA category but it shall have no specific media, no caption, just a photo story.
 - d. Additional contest categories in Binisayang Sinugboanon for secondary level only (Pagsulat og Balita, Pagsulat og Editoryal, Pagsulat og Feature, and Pagsulat og Balita Bahin sa Pagpaugnat sa Kusog)

e. Search for Outstanding School Paper Adviser (SPA) and Campus Journalist (CJ)

5. Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the Department adheres to the rule concerning plagiarism. DepEd reiterates its stand to disqualify school papers found to have copied and published texts, graphics and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. The disqualification covers all competition sections of the school paper whether they are published in print or PDF copy. Any form of plagiarism as proven by the board of judges shall be ground for disqualification.

6. In order to clarify issues and concerns regarding the conduct of the RSPC, concerned officials, and all participants are advised to refer to the list of enclosures on the guidelines of school paper, individual and group contests.

7. The Column Writing is now on its final year of exhibition contest. Contestants to this category are taken from the contestants on Editorial Writing or from any individual category. No separate contestants shall be organized for this category.

8. All schools divisions should strictly follow the **No School Paper, No Contestant Policy**.

9. Schools that have collected journalism subscription fees from their learners should submit school paper entries in print, **not in PDF files**.

10. Any violation of the stipulated guidelines is subject for disqualification.

11. Only the top five (5) winners in the individual contests and first place winners for the group contests in the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) shall be qualified for the RSPC.

12. For additional contests categories for SPAs and CJs, only the first place winners in the DSPC shall be qualified. No separate contestants shall be organized for these contests, they are part of the qualified official participants.

13. Schools Division Offices shall submit the official list of contestants not later than November 18, 2019 to maurita.ponce@deped.gov.ph. Submission of School Paper entries will be on or before November 15, 2019. (Follow the attached template).

14. A registration fee of **One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 1,500.00)** shall be collected from each participant/delegate, payable in cash to the host division on or before the conduct of the RSPC. This is to defray the expenses for the honoraria of the board of judges, kits, medals, trophies, transportation, equipment rental specially for TV broadcasting, contest supplies and materials, and other miscellaneous expenses. Membership fee of **Sixty Pesos (PhP 60.00)** for the SPA and **Thirty Pesos (PhP 30.00)** for the CJ shall also be collected by the CVSPAMI Treasurer during the registration.

15. Registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants are chargeable against school/division MOOE/SEF/PTA/Campus Journalism Funds, or other available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

16. Each delegation are encouraged to wear their delegation shirt, bring their delegation banner, and attend the Holy Mass at 3:00 p.m. and Opening Ceremonies at 4:00 p.m. on November 27, 2019 at the Mandaue City Sports Complex. No parade shall be conducted.

17. Checking of laptops and memory cards shall be at 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on November 27, 2019 at Mandaue City Comprehensive National High School for secondary level and at Mandaue City Central School for the elementary level.

18. A meeting with the Division Journalism Coordinators will be conducted on November 27, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. at the Conference Room of Mandaue City Central School.

19. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
