



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GUIDELINES FOR THE 13TH SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS QUIZ BOWL

A. The Contestants and Coaches

1. There must be four (4) contestants (Grade 5 or 6) per school and two (2) coaches.
 - a) Science Quiz Bowl (2 students and 1 Science Coach). The contestants may be 2 grade 5 pupils, 2 grade 6 pupils, or 1 grade 5 and 1 grade 6 pupils. The two pupils will work as a team in answering the Science Quiz Bowl.
 - b) Mathematics Quiz Bowl (2 students and 1 Mathematics Coach). The contestants may be 2 grade 5 pupils, 2 grade 6 pupils, or 1 grade 5 and 1 grade 6 pupils. The two pupils will work as a team in answering the Mathematics Quiz Bowl.
2. Pre-registration of schools will be made in their respective division office. The Schools Division Superintendents or Division Level Coordinators are requested to submit the list of pre-registered schools on or before **November 27, 2019** to the quiz bowl secretariat this email addresses ocd@cvisc.pshs.edu.ph or jphortezuela@cvisc.pshs.edu.ph.
3. There will be no registration fee for coaches and pupils. The on-site registration of the participants for the Division Level Eliminations will be at 8:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. on **December 2, 2019 (Monday)** in the designated venue per division.
4. The contestants should wear their school uniform and school ID.

B. The Contest

1. The contest consists of two levels: Division Level Eliminations (written) and Regional Level Quiz Bowl for both Science and Mathematics categories.
2. Division Level. A short orientation will be conducted at 9:00 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. The division level written eliminations will be at 9:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M. on **December 2, 2019** only at the designated venues for each division. Latecomers will not be given additional time. The scores of the two students in each school will then be added and the top three schools with the highest scores will be declared as winners during the awarding program in the afternoon. The champion team (top 1) will proceed to the regional level on **February 21, 2020** at **Robinsons Galleria, General Maxilom Avenue cor. Sergio Osmeña Blvd., Brgy. Tejero, Cebu City.** Furthermore, additional 5 top scorers across the region who do not win as champions in their division will be allowed to join the 19 champions from each division for the regional level quiz bowl.
3. The topics covered are Science and Mathematics concepts in the Grade 5 and Grade 6 Curriculum.
4. Regional Level. The regional level oral quiz bowl consists of easy, average and difficult rounds. Each question is worth 1, 2 and 3 points respectively. The quiz bowl




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is computer- aided. After every round, there will be one diskarte question in which the team can choose to answer or not. Should a team decides to answer a diskarte question and they get the answer correctly, an additional of 1, 2 and 3 points respectively will be given to the team; otherwise, they will be deducted with those corresponding points. Should a team decides NOT to answer a diskarte question, they will receive neither additional points or deductions.

In case, there will be questions regarding the answer, the contestant can only make a protest after the answer is announced and before the next question is read. The panel of judges will be the only one to decide on this matter. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

The top 3 highest scorers after the three rounds and all diskarte questions will be declared champion, first runner up and second runner up respectively. They will be awarded with trophies, medals, certificates, and other prizes. In case of a tie in these positions, a clincher round will be administered with a sudden death approach. The coach of the winning teams will receive certificates of recognition.

 All contestants and coaches will receive certificates of participation and certificates of appearance.
