1. Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 0075 s. 2019, all DepEd offices and schools shall participate in the conduct of the **CY 2019 1st Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)** scheduled on February 21, 2019 at 8:00AM (Thursday).
2. Herewith is the list of things to do in preparation for the earthquake drill:
 - Connect with Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) for an orientation on earthquake to understand intensity and possible impacts. Discuss preparedness measures.
 - Map out personnel/learners and contact numbers.
 - Determine communication flow among offices/schools and overall command system.
 - Determine personnel/learners with special needs in case of an earthquake; assign focal persons within the particular office/classroom to take charge of those personnel/learner with special needs.
 - Put up signages for evacuation routes and safe places to gather and/or evacuate to.
 - Ensure that everyone knows what to do during and after an earthquake.
 - Conduct post evaluation of the drill.
3. Photos and videos of the activity can be posted in our DRRM Facebook Group (DRRM DepEd NegOr) using the **#BidaAngHanda**, **#SafeAndResilientPh** and **#DepEdNegOrDRRM** as the official hashtags.
4. Evaluation forms (*see attached form*) will be submitted by respective schools to the District Office for consolidation, 2 days after the conduct of the NSED. District consolidated reports should be submitted to the Division Office on or before February 28, 2019 through the online form at **http://deped.in/NSEDnegor** or **https://goo.gl/9gxCLn**
5. Immediate and widest dissemination of the Memorandum to all concerned is hereby directed.

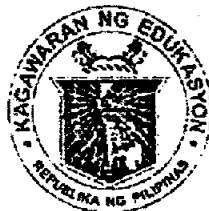

In connection with Memorandum No. 140, s. 2018 issued by the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC), offices across all levels of the Department and Schools are enjoined to participate in the 2019 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills (NSED), with schedule as follows:

1st Quarter	21 February 2019	Iloilo City, Panay Island
2nd Quarter	20 June 2019	Bayugan City, Agusan del Sur
3rd Quarter	08 August 2019	Ormoc City, Leyte
4th Quarter	14 November 2019	Calapan City, Mindoro

The objectives of the Quarterly NSED are:

1. To evaluate the awareness and readiness of learners and DepEd personnel to earthquakes; and
2. To evaluate the coordination and communication mechanisms during evacuation procedures and response.

Proper dissemination and post-activity evaluation of said drills are required. All field offices are advised to make necessary preparations to ensure that the required reports are submitted on time. (Please see Annex "A" for Submission Report Guidelines.)

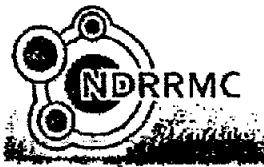
**Submission Report Guidelines for the
2019 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills**

All Schools, Schools Division offices, and Regional offices must follow the guidelines below or reports will not be accepted.

1. School DRRM Coordinators will submit the reports only to respective Division DRRM Coordinators not later than two (2) days after the Quarterly NSED.
2. Division DRRM Coordinators will consolidate NSED reports from School DRRM Coordinators and will submit only to respective Regional DRRM Coordinators, with copy provided to their respective Schools Division Superintendents, not later than ten (10) days after the Quarterly NSED.
3. Regional DRRM Coordinators will consolidate NSED reports from Division DRRM Coordinators and will submit to the DRRMS, with copy provided to their respective Regional Directors. Consolidated reports of the documentation and analysis of the Quarterly NSED must be submitted to drmo+NSED2019@deped.gov.ph not later than twenty (20) days after the Quarterly NSED.
4. Cut-off time for all deadlines will be 5:00 PM.

Rule 6, Section 7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the RA 10121 states that "Public awareness shall also be undertaken through the conduct of drills by the LDRRMO on a regular basis". Likewise, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) states that one of the activities to achieve Outcome 10: "Developed and implemented comprehensive national and local preparedness and response policies, plans and systems" is to develop/ enhance and simulate scenario-based preparedness and response plans. Furthermore, one of the policy framework stated in the National Disaster Preparedness Plan as embedded in the fourth priority area of the Sendai Framework for Action 2015-2030 includes the target: "to promote regular disaster preparedness, response and recovery exercises".

In view hereof, the schedule for the CY 2019 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) is hereby disseminated:


1 st Quarter	21 February 2019	Iloilo City, Panay Island
2 nd Quarter	20 June 2019	Bayugan City, Agusan Del Sur
3 rd Quarter	08 August 2019	Ormoc City, Leyte
4 th Quarter	14 November 2019	Calapan City, Mindoro

All NDRRMC member agencies, Metro Manila and RDRRMC member agencies and Regional Chairpersons of all RDRRMCs are enjoined to spearhead the conduct of earthquake drill in their areas of jurisdiction.

Proper documentation and the conduct of the Post Activity Evaluation is encouraged. Result of the analysis and documentation should be submitted to the OCD Capacity Building and Training Service through electronic mail at cbts@ocd.gov.ph not later than 20 days after the activity for consolidation and submission to the Chairperson, NDRRMC.
