- 4. School heads and school principals are not eligible to join but may nominate and endorse a nominee. Those holding administrative positions other than those mentioned above may join provided they carry a minimum of 6 hours/week teaching load.
- 5. All are encouraged to join provided the eligibility requirements are met.
- 6. Deadline for the submission of accomplished original nomination form to the Metrobank Foundation is on December 27, 2019.
