

3. To test the coordination and communication mechanism during response operations;
4. To understand the command and control mechanism in emergency and disaster operations at the DRRMCs.

In Central Visayas region, the ceremonial venue will be in Tagbilaran City, Province of Bohol.

In this regard, all RDRRMC member-agencies and Local DRRM Councils are enjoined to conduct the same safety drill in their respective areas and offices with proper documentation to be submitted to OCD7 at civildefense_rc7@yahoo.com not later than 7 days after the activity for consolidation and submission to the NDRRMC.

1. Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 0075 s. 2019, all DepEd offices and schools shall participate in the conduct of the **CY 2019 1st Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)** scheduled on February 21, 2019 at 8:00AM (Thursday).
2. Herewith is the list of things to do in preparation for the earthquake drill:
 - Connect with Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) for an orientation on earthquake to understand Intensity and possible impacts. Discuss preparedness measures.
 - Map out personnel/learners and contact numbers.
 - Determine communication flow among offices/schools and overall command system.
 - Determine personnel/learners with special needs in case of an earthquake; assign focal persons within the particular office/classroom to take charge of those personnel/learner with special needs.
 - Put up signages for evacuation routes and safe places to gather and/or evacuate to.
 - Ensure that everyone knows what to do during and after an earthquake.
 - Conduct post evaluation of the drill.
3. Photos and videos of the activity can be posted in our DRRM Facebook Group (DRRM DepEd NegOr) using the **#BidaAngHanda**, **#SafeAndResilientPh** and **#DepEdNegOrDRRM** as the official hashtags.
4. Evaluation forms (*see attached form*) will be submitted by respective schools to the District Office for consolidation, 2 days after the conduct of the NSED. District consolidated reports should be submitted to the Division Office on or before February 28, 2019 through the online form at **<http://deped.in/NSEDnegor>** or **<https://goo.gl/9gxCLn>**
5. Immediate and widest dissemination of the Memorandum to all concerned is hereby directed.
