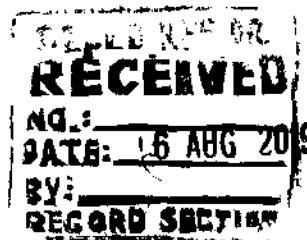

The Department of Labor and Employment through its Child Labor Prevention and Elimination Program (CLPEP) will start the second round of the nationwide "CHILD LABOR PROFILING" that aims to withdraw 630,000 children from their child labor condition. This is in line with the Philippine Development Plan for Children 2017-2022, dubbed as "Ambisyon Natin 2040".

Effective August 19, 2019, enumerators will be deployed in all cities and municipalities to conduct the Child Labor Profiling up to December 31, 2019, with monitoring assistance from the LGUs Public Employment Service Office (PESO).

Relative thereto, we would like to request for assistance from your office, through the Principal/Guidance Counselor/Teachers/PTA Officers of schools, on the following:

1. to help us identify/list possible children below the age of 17 years old who are engaged either in child work or child labor or in any economic activities with or without an employer
2. to set the schedule for the conduct of interview of these children with their parent/s in school
3. and if possible, to help our enumerators interview these children.

We look forward to a positive response on this request for our children's future.
