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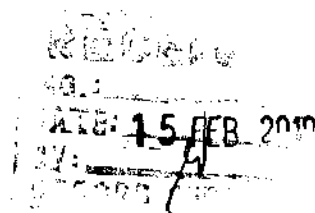

Dear Dr. Bongalos:

The Foundation University College of Education through its talents enhancement day (ted) program will be holding its first ever FUCE Brain Wars on February 22, 2019, 10:00AM at the Robinson's Dumaguete Main Atrium. In line with this, we are inviting the schools in the districts of Sibulan, San Jose, Amlan, Bacong, Dauin, Zamboanguita, and Valencia to send a group of 3 senior high school students (regardless of track and grade level) to join this activity. The game format will be as follows:

Round 1: Elimination Round

This round is a multiple choice quiz bee and is divided into 3 categories: easy, average, and difficult. The game show master will ask the question and the choices. The students will write down their answer on the official slate upon the signal of the game show master. Questions are taken from the following areas: Math, Science, Filipino, Social Studies, English, MAPEH and General Knowledge. The top 5 groups with the highest score will advance to the 2nd round.

Round 2: Semi Finals

This round is a spelling bee and is divided into 3 categories: easy, average, and difficult. The qualifiers to this round shall no longer work with their group but shall compete as individuals. The game show master will read the word to be spelled, it's part of speech, and its definition twice. Upon the game show master's signal, each contender shall write down the spelling on the official slate. The top 5 individuals with the highest score will advance to the 3rd and final round.

Round 3: Final Round

This round is picture interpretation. Each contestant will pick up a number representing the picture they are going to interpret. He/she is given 2 minutes to view the picture and make an outline of his/her speech which will be delivered in 3 to 5 minutes. The winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th) shall be decided upon by the members of the board of judges.
