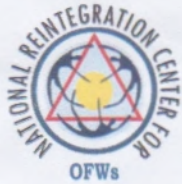

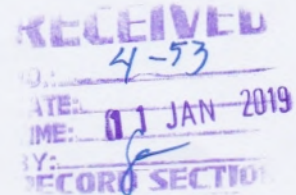



WHAT IS OUR PURPOSE?

Provide returning OFW-Licensure Examination for Teachers (OFW-LET) passers with gainful employment as public-school educators in the Philippines.

WHO CAN APPLY?

An applicant must be an OFW-LET passer and not have stayed or resided in the Philippines for more than three (3) years based on the his/her latest date of arrival. Depending on his/her teaching experience, an applicant may be required to undergo Online Refresher Course (ORC).

WHO NEEDS TO UNDERGO ORC?

The Online Refresher Course (ORC) of the PNU is intended for SPIMS applicants who do not have teaching experience for the past five years.

An applicant may apply through the Center's official website and social media account or may visit the nearest DOLE Regional Offices or Philippine Overseas Labor Office (POLO).

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

The SPIMS Secretariat will require the applicants to submit the following documents:

- a. Copy of Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) ID;
- b. Copy of Certificate of Board Rating;
- c. Copy of Passport (including the pages with arrival and departure stamps);
- d. Copy of Certificate of Employment abroad or any documentary proof; and
- e. Copy of Certificate of Employment as a teacher (if available).

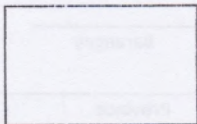
