Greetings from the Philippine Folk Dance Society!

We would like to invite you and all MAPEH Teachers, Trainers, Students from the schools of your division to the **1st Regional Folk Dance Workshop** scheduled on **September 13-15, 2019** at the **Negros Oriental State University Cultural Complex, Negros Oriental State University, Main Campus, Dumaguete City.**

The 3- day workshop will be conducted in partnership with the Philippine Folk Dance Society- National, the PFDS Negros Oriental Local Chapter and Negros Oriental State University.

Workshop activities include learning of **published folk dances specifically presented during the 39th National Folk Dance Workshop held last May 20-24, 2019 at the Folk Arts Theater of the Cultural Center of the Philippines, the review and learning of the fundamental dance steps, movements and select folk dances which are included in the new curriculum guide of the K-12 program for Dance and Physical Education and other related subjects.**

There are select topics on culture and the arts during the plenary sessions which will be discussed by invited speakers from the PFDS National Officers and from the Cultural Center of the Philippines specifically on the following areas:

1. **Research on Ata Dances, Songs and Games: A Qualitative Research**
2. **Staging and Choreographic Technique of Philippine Folk Dance**
3. **Proper Costuming and Props Production of Philippine Folk Dance**

A registration fee of **Two Thousand (P 2,000.00) for Professionals and One Thousand (P 1,000) for Students** shall be charged to cover the workshop expenses including workshop materials- dance handouts, CD, Workshop ID, Workshop T-shirt, Certificates, Honoraria for the Facilitators and Speakers and other incidental expenses. **The registration fee, transportation, accommodation and meals may be charged from the school's MOOE.**

Participants shall take care of their own transportation, accommodation and meals. Information about possible lodging and pension houses and hotels in Dumaguete City (for those participants who are not from Dumaguete City) may be facilitated by the local chapter officers and members.
