
2. 25 th PSA Bulletin 1 & 2	
Bulletin No. 1 GENERAL INFORMATION	<p>PSO Fortuito made mention of the objectives and significance of the PSQ, and who may compete in it. As per the bulletin, only first-time college freshmen students currently enrolled for the S.Y. 2019-2020 in any recognized tertiary academic institution can be considered. He then made a run-thru of the prizes at stake for the regional elimination.</p> <p>An inquiry to the DepEd representative, MT II Nida Barbara E. Suasin, was also made by PSO Fortuito as to the existence of courses/subjects on statistics in high school/secondary education as knowledge gained from this level will significantly impact the student's preparedness for the PSQ.</p> <p>As part of the major activities of PSA, PSO Fortuito also highlighted the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Implementation of the National ID System – to be fully implemented by March 20202. 2020 Census of Population and Housing – to be undertaken by May 20203. Community-Based Monitoring System – which is a localized data gathering of statistics supported by RA 10625, and is also in connection with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the Philippines involving (17) goals, (97) targets and (155) indicators.

OM re: 25 th PSQ Provincial and Regional Elimination	<p>PSO Fortuito read the memo for the information of the Steering Committee members.</p> <p>He notified that the schedule of the provincial elimination is set on 07 November 2019 (Thursday) at 01:00 PM while the regional elimination is scheduled on 12 November 2019, and that these are to be held simultaneously with other provinces and regions.</p> <p>He further informed that Silliman University has committed to host the PSQ in Negros Oriental. Also, that as of date, no school has yet confirmed their participation to the PSQ Provincial Elimination.</p>

6. 30 th National Statistics Month (NSM)	<p>PSO Fortuito read Proclamation No. 647 s. 1990 declaring every month of October of every year as National Statistics Month. He then proceeded to share the highlights of last year's NSM celebration at the national level where the opening ceremony was hosted by the Secretary of the Department of Tourism (DOT) and the closing was hosted by the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP). He then enumerated the activities of the PSA Negros Oriental in celebration of the 30th NSM to include the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Hanging of steamer – where all LGUs committed to hang streamers. In this connection, PSQ Steering Committee members were also asked to hang the same in their respective offices where photos and corresponding receipts of the steamer are to be sent to the PSA Negros Oriental email, psa07.negrosoriental@gmail.com.2. Vital Statistics Exhibit3. Statistical Data Dissemination Forum on Survey Results – where the PSQ Steering Committee Member Agencies were asked to send at most (3) participants per office.4. Basic Statistics and Infographics Training5. DVSS Forum for Solemnizing Officers and BHWs6. Basic Statistical Report Writing <p>During such time, he also made an introduction of the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) which is a localized data gathering of statistics in line with RA 10625, and is also connected with the Sustainable Development Goals of the Philippines covering (17) goals, (97) targets and (155) indicators.</p>
7. OM 2019-123 re: Convening/ Meeting of the Regional/ Provincial/ City/ Municipal Census Coordinating Boards (CCB) for the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (CPH)	<p>PSO Fortuito informed about the following major events relative to the conduct of the 2020 CPH:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Convention of the Provincial Census Coordinating Board (chaired by the Provincial Governor) no later than 15 November 2019 – It was agreed for DILG to draft the executive order for this purpose to be signed by the Provincial Governor. Further, that PSA will provide all the necessary documents to DILG as reference.2. Convention of Municipal/City CCB (chaired by respective Meyors) no later than 20 December – As agreed, this shall commence starting the 1st week of December. Also, that all members of the PSQ-PSC shall be included as members of the CCB. <p>Assistance from the PIA was sought for the promotion of the CCB.</p>



<p>8. PSA Board Resolution No. 04 s. 2019 re: Enjoining Agencies to Provide Assistance to the PSA for the conduct of the 2020 CPH</p>	<p>PSO Fortuito read the List of Assistance requested from Government Agencies as provided under PSA Board Resolution No. 04 s. 2019. With this, BSP representative, Dr. Beccay, voiced that BSP is open to serve as training venue for the 2020 CPH 3rd Level Training with up to 70 pax. In order to further disseminate the contents of the resolution, it was decided to have a Dialogue/Forum with the DepEd Superintendents of the different districts so as to relay the assistance they could provide for the conduct of the 2020 CPH. Adding to this, PSO Fortuito stressed that during the dialogue, it shall be requested for teachers who will be involved in the CPH to be spared from other activities and training, including brigada eskwela. Also, that teachers to serve as enumerators should be residents of the area of assignment.</p>

PSA Board Resolution No. 05 s. 2019 re: Creating the National, Regional, Provincial, City and Municipal Census Coordinating Boards for the 2020 CPH</p>	<p>The timetable of activities for the 2020 CPH was shared by PSO Fortuito to the steering committee members. As an added note, the body was informed that PSA shall especially hire teachers who know how to operate android phones/tablets.</p>
<p>10. Final PSQ-PSC Meeting</p>	<p>The 2nd and final meeting of the PSQ Steering Committee is set on 04 November 2019 at 02:00 PM. For this activity, steering committee members, board of judges, quizmaster, timekeeper, scorer and other persons involved in the actual conduct of the PSQ shall be invited.</p>
<p>11. Other Matters</p>	<p>As per information of Dr. Baccay, BSP will jumpstart the printing of the PhilSys ID by 1st quarter of 2020.</p>
