Dear Superintendent Bongalos,

OMF will take care of their roundtrip fares, accommodations (in a nearby hotel), and meals for the duration of the trip which will span a maximum of three (3) days, from September 22 to 24, 2019 (the ceremony will be held in the afternoon of September 23).

To promote the diversity of cultures in our country, we would like to request that the students attend the ceremonial lighting in an attire that would best showcase their rich tradition and cultural heritage of the province or municipality that they represent. School heads and teachers, however, are requested to come in their formal DepEd uniforms.

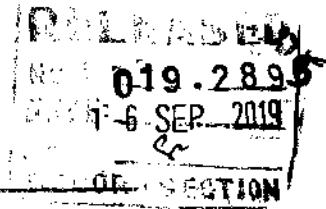
