

Since 1991, the Education Research Program (ERP) of the University of the Philippines Center for Integrative and Development Studies (UP-CIDS) is dedicated to the promotion of rigorous acholarship in the field of education. Some of ERP's research focuses on functional interacy, non-formal education, indigenization of curriculum, family studies and education, early childhood care and development, amongst others.

This year, one of ERP's strand of inquiry is on teacher professional development. Together with The HEAD Foundation, a charitable organization set up in 2013 in Singapore to contribute to the development of Asia through support in research and social initiatives, we are investigating how school learning action cells (LAC) would impact on improving teachers' knowledge, attitudes, and competencies in teaching Grade 6 Science.


