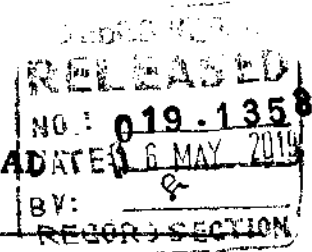



Dear Regional Director Jeruta,

Since 1991, the Education Research Program (ERP) of the University of the Philippines Center for Integrative and Development Studies (UP-CIDS) is dedicated to the promotion of rigorous scholarship in the field of education. Some of ERP's research focuses on functional literacy, non-formal education, indigenization of curriculum, family studies and education, early childhood care and development, amongst others.

This year, one of ERP's strand of inquiry is on teacher professional development. Together with The HEAD Foundation, a charitable organization set up in 2013 in Singapore to contribute to the development of Asia through support in research and social initiatives, we are investigating how school learning action cells (LAC) would impact on improving teachers' knowledge, attitudes, and competencies in teaching Grade 6 Science.

As such, we would like to partner with your region to empower Grade 6 Science teachers through the training of at least thirty (30) school heads and LAC facilitators for five (5) days in May 2019, preferably after the election, or on any date in May that you may deem convenient for them.

Among the topics that will be discussed during the training are:


1. organizing and managing LAC sessions;
2. curriculum analysis, contextualization, indigenization and localization of Grade 6 Science curriculum;
3. differentiated instruction;
4. ICT integration in instruction and assessment; and
5. formative assessment.

Our office will shoulder the training materials and expenses of trainers and facilitators. However, we would like to request that the expenses of DepEd participants and the workshop venue be covered by your office. We prepared a project cost estimate that would give you an idea of the expenses that would be incurred. Please refer to Annex 1 for Residential (Live-in) Workshop and Annex 2 for Non-Residential (Live-out) Workshop.
