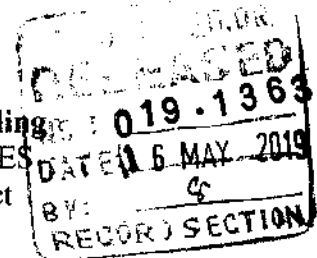

To: **SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS**

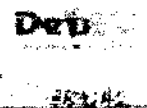
