

We are YGOAL Incorporated, the linking and learning organization for the Voice Programme in the Philippines. Voice is an innovative grant facility that supports the most marginalised and discriminated people in ten low- and lower-middle income countries in Africa and Asia. It aims to amplify and connect thus far unheard voices in efforts to leave no one behind. Voice is an initiative of and financed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Netherlands as part of their overall policy framework 'Dialogue and Dissent' and is executed by a consortium between Oxfam Novib and Hivos.

At the heart and soul of the Voice programme is linking and learning as it puts premium to the learning experiences and provides platforms for grantees, target beneficiaries and other stakeholders to share insights and learn from others. The CoS is a cocreated space that aspires to enable target groups and their organizations and networks to meet with other local actors. We are pilot-testing the Co5 for Visayas and Mindanao this Saturday, July 6, 2019 from 8:00 AM ~ 5:00 PM, final venue to be announced but definitely within the Metro Cebu area.
